What happens next?

Early-twentieth-century authors Nellie L. McClung, L.M. Montgomery, and Mazo de la Roche answered that question through the writing and publication of further instalments. McClung's Pearlie Watson trilogy, Montgomery's *Anne of Green Gables* books, and de la Roche's *Jalna* novels were read avidly not just as sequels, but also as serials in newspapers and magazines, and were adapted to stage, film, and television.

Wendy Roy argues in *The Next Instalment* that the serials, sequels, and adaptations of these three Canadian writers, born in the same decade of the nineteenth century, were part of a publication, marketing, and reading continuum that encouraged repeated consumption through development and extension of the original story.



**Wendy Roy** is Professor of Canadian Literature at the University of Saskatchewan.
